

Volunteer Lake Survey Directions

The hours you spend surveying the lake are used for in-kind hours match for both the Watershed Grant and the Aquatic Nuisance Grant. The amount allowed by both grants is \$12 per hour.

Milfoil only grows in water 10-15 feet deep, where sunlight can reach it. So our search will be on the edges of the lake. The map shows the depth of Echo Lake to 20 feet deep.

If you think you see an invasive species, take a sample very carefully. A little piece of watermilfoil that floats off from the larger plant will take root. Mark where you found the sample by sighting 3 land objects whose lines intersect.

Fill out the form completely. If you only survey a portion of any section just mark, as accurately as you can, where you looked.

If you have suggestions for how to break the map up into smaller portions, write the landmark that will serve as the border of the new section on the map. I will make the changes on the next copies.

Hand the completed sheets into the Echo Lake Association.
